### *Why A Neighborhood Association?*

As neighbors, we felt like we could be doing a better job of connecting with each other, looking out for each other, and making our neighborhood a safer place. So, we've decided to form a neighborhood association with those goals in mind and would love it if you would join us.

### *What is the Holiday Park Neighborhood Association (HPNA)?*

HPNA is a voluntary organization open to the people and businesses that call the Holiday Park area home. If you own a home, rent a home or have a business in the area, then HPNA is for you.

### *What Will Our Association Do?*

Our main efforts in the beginning will be focused on making our neighborhood a safer place. Our goal is to get enough members to be able to pay off-duty Bernalillo County Sheriff's Deputies to patrol our neighborhood in their marked cars. It costs \$48 an hour to have a patrol come through our neighborhood. So, the more members who join us, the more police hours we can afford! We hope this will encourage any criminal elements that would otherwise target our homes to seek easier prey elsewhere.

HPNA will also serve as the official line of communication between our neighborhood and the city government. If the city wants to change something in our area, the HPNA will be among the first to know and will be able to get the word out to our members. HPNA will also be able to give feedback to the city based on what our members tell us.

We plan on hosting neighborhood get-togethers – things like block parties and Easter-egg hunts at the park. This will give us all more opportunity to get to know our neighbors. We'll also coordinate neighborhood cleanup initiatives like cleaning the arroyo and graffiti removal.
